The Florida Board of Bar Examiners, through its Chair, the Honorable Jane A. Rose of Tampa, Florida, has announced that the grades from the July 2021 Bar Examination have been approved for release by the Supreme Court of Florida.

On July 27-28, 2021, 3,343 applicants took the online remote Bar Examination. 2,285 applicants were taking the examination in Florida for the first time. The Supreme Court posted the pass/fail results for each applicant on its website and score reports were mailed or posted to each applicant's portal today.

The Court approved 1,483 candidates for admission to The Florida Bar on September 20, 2021, and Chief Justice Charles T. Canady has announced that they may be sworn in as members of The Florida Bar. Formal induction ceremonies, hosted by the Supreme Court and the 2nd through the 5th Florida District Courts of Appeal, will be held to swear in the new attorneys on October 13, 2021.

JULY 2021 GENERAL BAR EXAMINATION OVERALL METHOD

The Supreme Court of Florida has released the following bar examination statistical information developed by the Florida Board of Bar Examiners. These results apply to the July 2021 General Bar Examination administered remotely on July 27-28, 2021. This datum applies to only those persons sitting for the examination in Florida for the first time.
